Congressman Schweikert Voted 12 Times To Cut Social Security or Medicare and Recommended That Seniors Should Delay Their Retirement

Over the course of his tenure in the U.S. House, Congressman Schweikert has voted 12 times to cut Social Security or Medicare. He's voted to raise the retirement age, and just last year he suggested that seniors should push back their retirements and work longer.

Congressman Schweikert voted against the Inflation Reduction Act, a life-changing legislation that lowers prescription costs by allowing Medicare to negotiate lower costs and reduces health insurance costs for families.

Congressman Schweikert Voted Against Raising the Minimum Wage

Congressman Schweikert has voted against raising the federal minimum wage multiple times, including by opposing the Raise the Wage Act. The current federal minimum wage of \$7.25 has not been increased since 2009

The GOP Tax Scam package includes the expansion of some corporate tax breaks initially enacted in the Republicans' 2017 Tax Scam.
